RE: Indoor Air Quality Inspection Report – August 2023 Janvier Elementary School Epic Project No. 23-2269

Dear Mr. Zeck:

Epic Environmental Services, LLC (Epic) was retained by the Franklin Township Board of Education (District) to perform indoor air quality inspections for five randomly selected areas at the Janvier Elementary School. One additional sample was taken specifically in the counselor's office. The inspections consisted of visual observations and the collection of temperature and relative humidity data. Additionally, samples for airborne mold spores were collected in the inspection areas.

The visual inspections focused on signs of moisture, water intrusion, and visible mold growth.

Temperature and relative humidity data were compared to current New Jersey Indoor Air Quality and industry standards.

Epic Environmental performed the inspections on August 28/29, 2023.

Acceptable Temperature and Relative Humidity Criteria

Acceptable Indoor Temperature Range: 68° - 79° Fahrenheit Ideal Relative Humidity Range: 30-60%

Room 36, Room 29, Room 18, Art Room, Room 10, Counselor's Office

Observations, Comments, and Recommendations

Weather Conditions: Mostly Cloudy, 75° Fahrenheit, 78% Relative Humidity

Room 36

No visible mold was observed.

Relative humidity was within the ideal range (56%). Temperature was within the acceptable range.

Airborne mold spore concentrations were near or below outside (background) concentrations.

Relative humidity was slightly elevated (67%). Temperature was within the acceptable range.

Airborne mold spore concentrations were near or below outside (background) concentrations.

Relative humidity was slightly elevated (67%). Temperature was within the acceptable range.

Airborne mold spore concentrations were near or below outside (background) concentrations.

No visible mold was observed.

No evidence of recent water intrusion was observed.

Relative humidity was within the ideal range (47%). Temperature was within the acceptable range.

Airborne mold spore concentrations were near or below outside (background) concentrations.

No action required at this time.

Room 10

No visible mold was observed.

No evidence of recent water intrusion was observed.

Relative humidity was within the ideal range (52%). Temperature was within the acceptable range.

Airborne mold spore concentrations were near or below outside (background) concentrations.

No action required at this time.

Counselor's Office

No visible mold was observed.

The carpeted floor was damp.

Relative humidity was slightly elevated (62%). Temperature was within the acceptable range.

Airborne Paecilomyces mold spore concentrations were slightly elevated.

Recommendations given to clean surfaces and dry the carpet were given.

Air Sample Results

Air samples were collected in each inspection area. Airborne Paecilomyces mold spore concentrations were slightly elevated in the counselor's office. Airborne mold spore concentrations were near or below background (outside) concentrations in all other areas.

Conclusions and General Recommendations

- Assure steps are taken to maintain a maximum relative humidity concentration of 60% during the summer months. This will reduce the overall probability of triggering mold activity.
- Ensure all carpets are fully dried after cleaning/wetting.
