1. Approved the following 2007-2008 School Level Planning Objectives:

**School/Principal(Years)/Pupil Performance/Behavior Objectives**

**M.F. Janvier/Mr. Ettore(07-08)** By the Spring of 2008, due to the implementation of fluency development lessons, at risk Grade Two Language Arts/Literacy students will increase oral reading fluency and word count per minute scores by at least 75% from September, 2007 benchmark administration to the final one administered in June, 2008.

**M.F. Janvier/Mr. Ettore(07-09)** By the Spring of 2009, due to the use of Six Trait writing techniques and the Four Square graphic organizer, Grade Two students will improve in their ability to write in response to a picture prompt. Standard and level of achievement to be determined by June, 2008.

**C.L. Reutter/Mr. Weigelt(07-09)** By June 2009, as a result of using strategies to improve reading comprehension and the diagnostic data from the Measure of Academic Progress assessment test, fourth grade students will demonstrate improved proficiency in reading comprehension as measured by a pre and post testing using the MAP assessment. Standard and level of achievement to be determined by June, 2008.

**C.L. Reutter/Mr. Weigelt(07-09)** By June 2009, as a result of using strategies to improve oral reading fluency, third grade students will demonstrate improved proficiency in oral reading fluency as measured by a timed oral reading assessment. Standard and level of achievement to be determined by June, 2008.

**Main Road/Mr. Dantine(07-08)** By June 2008, as a result of using strategies to improve student performance in the area of mathematics, special education students in grade 3,4, and 5 will achieve adequate yearly progress (75% proficient or above), or reach "Safe Harbor" by achieving a 10% decrease in the failure rate.

**Main Road/Mr. Dantine(07-08)** By June 2008, as a result of using strategies to improve student performance in the area of LAL, special education students in grades 3,4 and 5 will achieve adequate yearly progress (75 % proficient or above), or reach "SafeHarbor" by achieving a 10% decrease in the failure rate.

12. Approved the Board Secretary's Monthly Certification that as of September 30, 2007, no budgetary line item account has been overexpended in violation of of N.J.A.C. 6A:23-2.12(c)3.
13. Certified that as of September 30, 2007, after review of the Board Secretary's and Treasurer's Monthly Financial Reports, and upon consultation with the appropriate district officials, that to the best of our knowledge no major account or fund has been overexpended in violation of of N.J.A.C. 6A:23-2.12 (c)4 and that sufficient funds are available to meet the district's financial obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year.
