The Township of Franklin Board of Education at its special meeting of January 10, 2007 and regular meeting of January 17, 2007 acted upon the following matters:

1. Established the deadline for candidates to file nominating petitions for the 2007 Annual School Election with the School Business Administrator/ Board Secretary to be February 26, 2007 by 4:00 p.m.
2. Established the date to draw the names for candidate ballot position for the 2007 Annual School Election on March 7, 2007, at 4:05 p.m. in the Administration Building.
3. Approved the resolution for School Board Recognition Month in New Jersey, January 2007.
4. Approved homeless student Tuition Contract Agreements for the 2006-2007 school year.
5. Approved the Superintendent and School Business Administrator/Board Secretary arranging transportation and making tuition placement of a student for the 2006-2007 school year.
6. Approved homebound instruction for a student.
7. Approved the collaboration/articulation agreement with the Gloucester County Special Services School District for the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Education Project for the 2007-2008 school year.
8. Approved the list of bills for the month of January.
9. Approved the payroll for the month of December.
10. Accepted the reports of the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary and Treasurer of School Monies for the period ending December 31, 2006 and acknowledge that they are in agreement.
11. Approved the Board Secretary's Monthly Certification that as of December 31, 2006, no budgetary line item account has been overexpended in violation of N.J.A.C. 6A:23-2.11.
12. Certified that as of December 31, 2006, after review of the Board Secretary's Monthly Financial Report (appropriations sections) and upon consultation with the appropriate district officials, that to the best of our knowledge no major account or fund has been overexpended in violation of N.J.A.C. 6A:23-2.11 and that sufficient funds are available to meet the district's financial obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year.
13. Approved Budget Transfers for the month of January.
14. Approved the anticipated Revenue Summary as of December 31, 2006 as submitted by the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary.
15. Approved the shared services agreements with the Municipality of the Township of Franklin.
16. Approved the employment of substitutes for the 2006-2007 school year.
17. Approved a temporary unpaid leave of absence for Scott Gant, Custodian.

18. Accepted the retirement resignation of Joseph Mielewski, Supervisor of Technology/Special Programs, effective July 1, 2007 (Mr. Mielewski has been employed in the district since July, 2001).
19. Accepted the resignation of Amy Capriotti, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary, effective February 16, 2007.
20. Approved the revised job description for Transportation Supervisor.
21. Acknowledged the successful probationary employment for Dore Sabella, Teacher Aide; and Debra Unkow, Library Media Aide.
22. Approved the teacher aide reassignment of Faith Abagnale for the 2006-2007 school year.
23. Approved AFLAC to provide voluntary supplemental benefits to district employees through payroll deduction for the 2006-07 school year.
24. Authorized the Affirmative Action team to conduct a needs assessment and develop a Comprehensive Equity Plan for 2007-2010.
25. Approved the temporary suspension of the retirement provision of Policy 4151, Attendance, for the remainder of the 2006-2007 school year.
26. Approved architect Wayne Neville to send final submission of the Caroline L. Reutter School addition, including specifications, construction documents and state application to the New Jersey Department of Education for final educational approval.
27. Accepted the donation of a DVD player for Ms. Jakubek's classroom at Mary F. Janvier School, from the Pugliese family.
28. Approved the revised specifications for the purchase of two 54-passenger school buses, and authorize the School Business Administrator/Board Secretary to advertise for bids.
29. Approved a resolution regarding a student residency settlement agreement.
30. Denied the residency status of a student and assessed tuition charges in accordance with policy.
31. Approved a resolution opposing Senate Bill S-7 which would create a county administrative district pilot program.
