

STUDENT ATTENDANCE AREAS

The Board of Education shall establish attendance areas for each school building. Students shall attend the school building based strictly upon their residence in a specific school building attendance area.

The only exceptions to a student's enrollment in a school building based upon the respective attendance area which will be considered are as follows;

- ▼ Individual Education Plan for student requires a program which is not available in the attendance area school building or specifies another school building for educational purposes. In such a circumstance, the parent may request that the sibling(s) attend the same school. Should the sibling(s) be older, a request may be made to attend the out of attendance area school prior to the attendance of the special education student. However, such an accommodation shall not require the rerouting of a bus route to accommodate transportation needs. The parent may provide transportation.
- ▼ The relocation of a student's residence within the Township of Franklin. Such request shall be made in writing to the Superintendent within thirty days of such relocation and shall not require the rerouting of an existing bus route to accommodate transportation needs.
- ▼ Child care arrangements in accordance with Regulation 3541 - Transportation Requests.

The Superintendent's decision regarding the student's designated school building of attendance shall be final.
