

NON RESIDENT STUDENTS

A. Future Residents

A child otherwise eligible for attendance whose parent/guardian has signed a contract to buy, build, or rent a residence in this district may be enrolled in accordance with the following:

Before the beginning of the school year, the payment of tuition, one month in advance, will be required prior to enrollment and by the first day of each subsequent month. If residency within the school district is established prior to the beginning of the second marking period, all tuition paid will be refunded. Should residency within the school district be established after the first marking period, all tuition paid will be forfeited. The date of occupancy shall terminate tuition charges and a refund will be made accordingly on a calendar day per diem basis.

During the school year, the payment of tuition, one month in advance, will be required prior to enrollment. If residency within the school district is established within thirty (30) calendar days of the enrollment date, all tuition paid will be refunded. Should residency within the school district be established after thirty (30) calendar days of the enrollment date, all tuition paid will be forfeited. The date of occupancy shall terminate tuition charges and a refund will be made accordingly on a calendar day per diem basis.

Approval for attendance as a future resident shall be limited to the current school year. Requests for a subsequent school year shall be subject to the approval of the Board prior to the enrollment of the child for that school year.

Parents/guardians of children who are future residents shall be required to demonstrate proof of the anticipated residency. The Board reserves the right to verify such claims.

B. Former Residents

Regularly enrolled children whose parents/guardians have moved out of the school district may be permitted to finish the school year without payment of tuition, provided that the parents/guardians move from the district after April 30 of the school year. Students whose parents/guardians have moved out of the district prior to May 1 must transfer to the school district to which they have moved.

C. Nonresident Students

Nonresident students may be admitted to this district on payment of tuition if a receiving-sending contract has been signed by another Board of Education. This shall also include attendance that is justified on the basis of living full-time and not just for the school year with district residents because of temporary personal or financial hardship in their own family. The Superintendent shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident children which admit such children only on the proper application of the parent/guardian.

The Superintendent shall report to the Board for its information and consent the enrollment of each nonresident student. The Board shall not be responsible for the transportation to or from school of any nonresident student.

Tuition rates shall be determined by the Board of Education upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and School Business Administrator/Board Secretary.

Tuition shall be charged monthly, in advance of attendance, and shall be due the first day of the month.
