

ASSIGNMENT TO SCHOOLS, CLASSES, AND TEACHERS

The board directs the superintendent to assume the responsibility of assigning students to their various grades and buildings. The superintendent delegates the responsibility of assigning students to their respective classroom teacher to the building principal. Decisions for assignments shall be based on the individual student's needs as they are identified as part of the district's student assessment procedures balanced with sound educational principles of grouping for instruction and the existing instructional arrangement structure of the district's program.

Generally, parent requests on behalf of their child for specific teacher assignments will not be considered. However, it is recognized that occasionally extenuating circumstance may exist that when brought to the attention of the principal may influence his/her decision regarding the child's teacher assignment.

Parents who request specific teacher assignments for their child must submit the reasons for such request in writing to the respective building principal prior to June 1 of the previous school year. The decision of the principal regarding the teacher assignment shall be final.
