

SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL SELECTION PROCEDURE

The following procedures shall be adhered to in selecting students to serve on their school safety patrol. The respective School Safety Patrol Advisor shall be responsible for implementing the selection process in accordance with this regulation.

1. The roster of all 5th and/or 6th grade students will be distributed to each teacher of grade 4 and/or 5 with a memo regarding Safety Patrol Selection.
2. On the class roster each respective teacher shall be requested to:
 - a. Indicate by a check next to each respective student's name whom they feel is responsible, dependable, sets a good example for other students, completes assignments, maintains satisfactory grades, and demonstrates good citizenship.
 - b. Leave a blank next to each respective student's name whom they do not have adequate personal knowledge to make a recommendation or whom they do not recommend.
3. Class rosters must be returned by the date requested on the Safety Patrol Selection form. (Exhibit 5142.21)
4. Nominations shall be selected according to the highest number of checks which indicate the most qualified students for each respective 5th and/or 6th grade. A lottery or ballot process may be used if the Advisor deems there are more than enough equally qualified students in a particular grade level. The lottery or ballot process will only be used for those students who have equal eligibility for the remaining positions which have not been filled by more eligible students.
5. Advisors shall endeavor to maintain an equal number of boys and girls on the Safety Patrol from each respective grade level.
6. Advisors have the option of working with 5th and/or 6th grade students based on qualified students available. The advisors will assess the needs of their respective building to determine the number of patrol persons.
7. Advisors shall review this regulation annually and advise their respective principal of any suggested revisions.
